# The Units

▶ Unit 1 Human Lifespan Development - External assessment - 1.5 hour exam /80marks

▶ Unit 5 Promoting Health Education – Internal assessment – Pearson Set Assignment Brief (PSAB)





Social care deals with supporting vulnerable people with the daily activities of life such as feeding, basic hygiene, independence, social interaction etc.






- **Primary** effects on the respiratory system






