We would like to invite all students to take part in our Colour Run event, to raise money for Medway Maritime Hospital. The event will take place on

Friday 11th July 2025

The Colour Run will take place after lunchtime at 2.05pm on the field and students will run/walk the course by going through four paint stations. The run will be opened by Tedway Bear, the Medway Hospital Charity mascot, who is joining us for the celebration!

The colour powder is made from corn starch dyed with food grade colouring. It is non-toxic and is not harmful to the skin but can cause eye irritation. Therefore, for safety reasons sunglasses or goggles MUST be worn throughout the event. If your child isn't wearing either of these they will not be allowed to participate. The colour powder might not wash out of clothes so please ensure your child brings in suitable old clothes and trainers that they don't mind getting stained. Plain white t-shirts are recommended but not compulsory.
