Dear Parents and Carers,

With GCSE exams approaching, we want to share a resource that can support Year 11 students with their revision at home.

Students now have access to a **Study Hub**, a digital platform designed to help them revise effectively and prepare for their exams. The platform works on any device and is simple to access. There are no individual accounts to create and no personal data required. Students use a shared login and can begin using the resources immediately.

The Study Hub is intended to sit alongside students' independent revision. It contains four key areas designed to support preparation for exams:

- **Study Skills** – guidance on how to revise effectively and organise learning
- **Exam Preparation** – techniques to approach exam questions and manage time
- **Resilience** – strategies to stay motivated and focused during the exam period
- **Wellbeing** – advice to support students in managing stress and maintaining balance

Within each section, students can access short, animated videos, practical guidance from experienced presenters, and downloadable revision guides and templates that they can use straight away. The platform also contains a large and expanding collection of **past GCSE exam papers**, allowing students to practise exam technique and become familiar with the style of questions they will face.

The platform also includes an AI Assistant that students can use to ask questions and receive immediate support. This tool has been trained using the platform's study content alongside national curriculum materials, helping to ensure that responses are relevant and suitable for GCSE students. Importantly, no student data is collected, and conversations are not stored or used to train external AI systems.

Students who may be feeling anxious about exams can also use the AI Assistant to access advice on managing stress, organising revision, or simple wellbeing strategies such as breathing techniques. It provides a quiet and accessible form of support that students can use whenever they need it.



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We encourage students to make regular use of the Study Hub as part of their revision routine over the coming weeks.

Thank you for your continued support as we work together to help Year 11 students prepare confidently for their GCSE examinations.
